Join us for two days and two nights of warmth and relaxation, drawing and painting beautiful roses and other spring flowers at The Bishop's Ranch in Healdsburg. Colored Pencils are a fun, safe and portable and meditative way to express oneself artistically. We will explore a variety of colored pencil techniques and learn how to blend, burnish and create new colors while incorporating the techniques of botanical drawing. We will also play with ways to incorporate and work with watercolor pencils and do some journaling outside.

All levels welcome.

Workshop is limited to 12 participants. Accommodations and meals during your stay are all inclusive. Non-alcoholic beverages are included with meals.

About the Artist:

Nina Antze is a California botanical artist and quiltmaker. She has a degree in Fine Art and a Certificate in Botanical Illustration from the New York Botanical Gardens and has recently studied with Sarah Simblet at the Ruskin School of Art at Oxford.

Nina teaches Colored Pencil classes in the Botanical Certificate Program at Filoli Gardens, at the Sebastopol Center for the Arts, Santa Rosa Junior College, the San Francisco Botanical Gardens, Point Reyes, and around the Bay Area.
